



COVID 19- Alert Level 3 Update: 21 April 2020

Kia ora koutou,

Yesterday the Government decided that we will move to Alert level 3 on 28 April. This means we will re-open to receive some children from Wednesday 29th April.

The key message for you the parents, is that if you can, you should keep your child at home.

You should only send your child to the centre if you need to.

The Ministry of Education are working closely with the health officials to develop clear guidelines that will support us to safely re-open and meet the public health requirements.

Rest assure, we will be operating with strict enforcement of health and safety measures as we want to keep our community as safe as possible. If your child has a health condition or they are sick they must stay at home.

We will be contacting you later in the week to find out if you can continue to keep your child at home, or if you need your child to attend from Wednesday 29th April.

We expect to have all the guidelines regarding our operating requirements back from the Ministry of Education by Thursday 23 April and we will update you as soon as we can.
